<u>Medical Qigong Training</u> is an energetic skill development and personal healing for both health care professionals and lay persons, optionally leading to certification as a Medical Qigong Practitioner, Therapist and Master. Certification is given by Empty Mountain Institute.

Medical Qigong is an ancient form of Chinese Energetic Medicine, dating back at least 5,000 years. It is one of the four branches of Traditional Chinese Medicine. Gifted Qigong Master Teacher, **Wendy Lang,** MMQ and Qigong Instructor, **John F. Weiss**, MMQ will be offering practitioner training online via Zoom. It is a profound training for self-transformation and becoming a well-balanced practitioner.

**Schedule**: The Medical Qi Gong Practitioner program is presented in a series of four seminars comprised of 10 half-day workshop intensives of 2x5 days each online via Zoom. The year is closed out with a 3 day online clinic for the general public also on Zoom.

**Tuition Fees:** The whole course of four 10-day seminars and one 3-day clinic is \$4,355. Each seminar is \$995 (for a total \$3980) plus \$375 for the clinic.

**NOTE:** The textbooks aren't required for the first seminar, but are needed by the second seminar.

**<u>Reading List</u>**: You are not required to read the material in the entire reading list before the class. It is recommended to do so afterwards to that you have a better understanding of the material, if you so choose. Some people read it while preparing for their take home "exams" after the course. The syllabus shows how the reading covers all the books. They are a great reference to have for energy work.

**DVDs**: Taoist Five Qigong Workout DVD by Wendy Lang, \$20 CAD (and FREE if you buy your books from Wendy directly)

**Self-Study**: The biggest commitment would be to a minimum of one hour per day for exercise and meditation practice. The reading and tests are on top of that, but the homework/exam shouldn't take more than 6 hours, and the reading should be maybe 10 hours. There are usually at least 8 weeks between classes, so approx. 2 hours study per week. You will be given a chart for you to keep track of this, but you don't have turn it in. It is to help you see how much time you're spending on practice and to encourage you to manage your time in a way that will be most beneficial for you.

**Exams**: There are 3 take home exams, which assist you in reading the books and contemplating your experience of energy work. The 4th exam is written in class. It is not stressful or complex and supports your understanding of the essentials. **All exams MUST be turned in to receive your certificate**.

<u>Certificates</u> – Upon successful completion all seminars, exams and the year-end clinic, you will receive a certificate from Empty Mountain Institute. You are then welcome to continue your studies in the Therapist level.

**<u>Practicum</u>**: In order to complete the program with International Association of Qigong and Shamanic Chinese Medicine (IIQSCM), you must complete 48 hours of practicum. The practicum does not need to be completed before you take the Therapist program. The Practicum can include:

No more than 12 hours of classes/workshops demonstrating the Medical Qigong workout No more than 12 hours on sessions with animals

No more than 24 hours of long distance sessions

Majority of the sessions should be one-to-one with the person with you on a massage table. Also, we need to have at least 6 write ups of which one should be a case study of multiple sessions.

<u>All Levels Clinic</u> is for all levels of students to work together on outside clients in the morning and exchanges later in the afternoon after group discussions. This is also a requirement for IIQSCM certification.
